Games will be played on one quarter of a standard football pitch. The [Afripixel Press Corps](#) will be given free access to capture the action.



How the Competition will work:

Only members of the **Afrapixel Press Corps** will be eligible to enter the competition (so get busy and sign up to be part of this elite group)

The **Afrapixel Press Corps** will be required to submit their copy online to the **dedicated gallery** on the website **www.afripixel.com** by no later than midnight Sunday 28 March 2010.

A Maximum of 10 images per **Afrapixel Press Corps** member may be uploaded as entries to the competition. The editors of **Photocomment** Magazine will choose from the images posted to the dedicated gallery which image they believe is worthy of publication. The selected images will be requested from the **Afrapixel Press Corps** member on Monday 29 March 2010, and the original copy must be submitted directly to the Editor concerned for publication. The image will be published in the next edition, together with a credit to the photographer concerned, alongside the article describing the event.

Over the next two weeks, until Saturday 17 April 2010, all registered visitors to the site will be asked to vote on which image they believe to be the best.
