As advanced as modern cameras are, they will never be able to replace the need for shot specific choices that great photographs require. This course teaches you all the basic principles of photography and helps you make the correct choices to immediately improve your results.

The course is presented on one evening or morning a week over five consecutive weeks, with an early morning outing on the Sunday before the last class. You are required to complete practical assignments on the course which become an important part of your learning curve. To do the course you need a digital SLR camera and a tripod.
